NECESSARY INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE NEW MEMBERS AND RULES OF THE CLUB

THE RULES OF WLOPA

1. **HUNTING CLUB PROPERTY:** Hunters must have a valid Connecticut hunting license, WLOPA membership card and club hunting permit. Only designated bird species may be hunted. No fur bearing animals may be hunted on the property. You must obtain tags from the Game Committee Chairman.
2. While on club property every member shall carry their membership card and must present it upon request to any person asking to see it.
3. Picking up spent cases and shotgun hulls is the responsibility of every club member. When you shoot, clean it up.
4. No one is allowed to shoot at the ranges if the red flag is displayed denoting that the range is closed.
5. Members must report to club officers any infraction of these rules or any unsportsmanlike conduct among the members of the Corporation.
6. Any member has the authority to warn off any person(s) trespassing upon the Property.
7. Anyone convicted of a felony need not apply for membership.
8. **FEES:**
 - A. All new members shall perform 10 hours of work detail as required by the by-laws. If 10 hours are not completed by the 1st anniversary date, the member will be billed \$150. If the \$150 is not paid, the member will be terminated. All work cards must be turned into a club officer or membership chairman.
 - B. All checks or money orders are to be made payable to WLOPA.
 - C. At the night of the new member induction, you are asked to turn in a check for either of the following:
